

# LISLATIVE PROCEEDINGS

House of Delegates—Carolina County  
County—From citizens of Rowan  
to be granted by an amendment of  
Senate.

North Carolina—  
Senate—Bills relating to  
payment of debts due to  
the state—The bill to  
allow the state to sue for  
debt due to it was adopted.

Senate—Jury resolution concerning  
the drainage of the creek.  
Bill introduced by Senator Braxton  
and Chairman of the Committee on  
Internal Improvement.

House—By request—An act to  
allow the Internal Improvement Fund  
to float bonds.

Senate—Amendment of the  
bill to allow the Internal Improvement  
Fund to float bonds.

Jones—Establish a dispensary at  
Kingsport in Greene county.

Murphy—Transfer Yancey county  
to the thirteenth judicial district and  
change the time for holding courts at  
Brown and Dryden counties.

Morgan—Amend Revised Statutes  
so as to allow the state to sue for  
debt due to it.

Pope—Allow commissioners of  
Rockingham \$25 per day and mileage  
for a round trip between the  
state and timber.

Murphy—Amend  
Statute of Limitations  
so as to provide more  
time for the recovery  
of debts.

Parsons—Provide for  
straightening and  
draining Leopard Creek in Davie  
county. A similar bill which had  
passed was amended so it would  
have had a roll call as it is believed.

Galloway, of Green—Make indirect  
taxes void if contract be  
sworn fraudulently.

Hill—On first reading:

Amend road law of Clay county.

Decatur—Bill, No. 10, of Gaston  
Senate—Passed.

Antelope—Bill to issue bonds  
and levy a spend tax. Passed.

An amendment to the Decatur  
surface bill passed yesterday was  
adopted amending the insurance  
commissioner to revoke the license of  
any insurance company which fails  
to make monthly contributions for  
political purposes.

The Manning bill for requiring  
police officers and  
others to pay gift
