Miss Bessie Belle is improving nicely after a tonsil operation Oct. 25th.

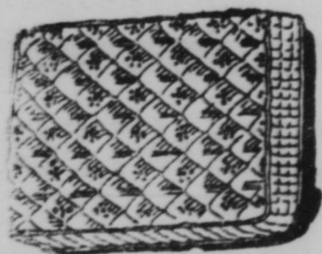

The attention of music makers is called to the old-time Fiddler's Convention which will be held at Harris School, Nov. 6, Friday night, by the Parent-Teachers Association.

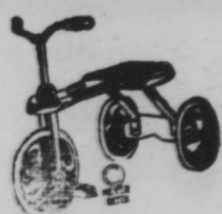
