ENGLAND HAS NEW KING

The abdication of King Edward of Great Britain was last week's news sensation. Renouncing the throne because he felt that he could not perform the duties of his position without the help of the woman he loved, England's monarch bade farewell to his family at a private dinner and to his subjects in a radio address, leaving soon afterwards for France, from where he went on to Austria and is staying at a castle near Vienna be-

claimed king. The date set for his coronation is May 12, the time previously decided upon for his brother.

Many and varying opinions have been expressed with regard to Edward's action in giving up the throne. They range from classing the action as the greatest romantic gesture of history to considering it the act of a person not wholly developed emotionally and who put personal gratification ahead of duty.

The new ruler will reign as George VI.

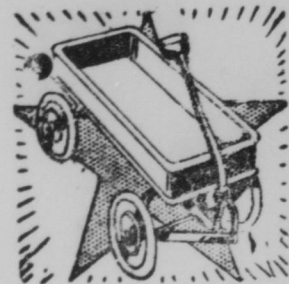
