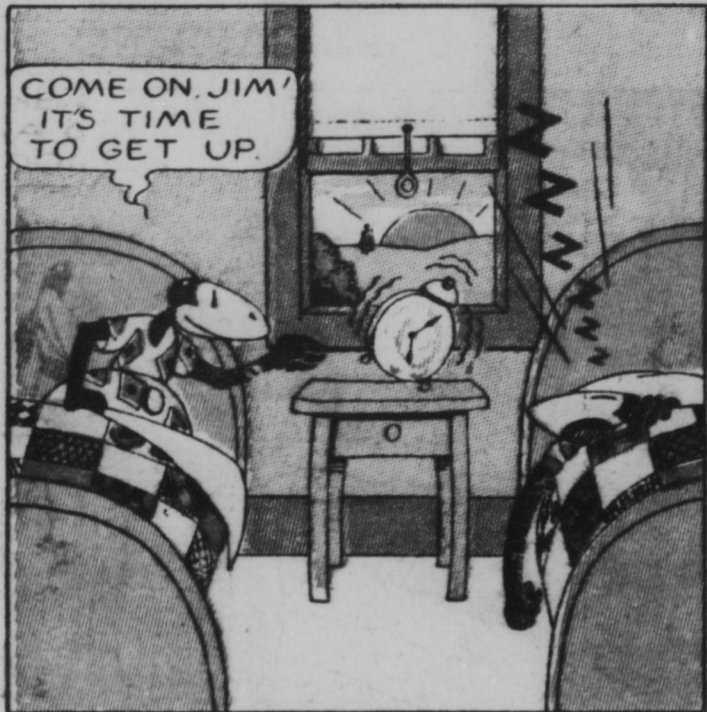


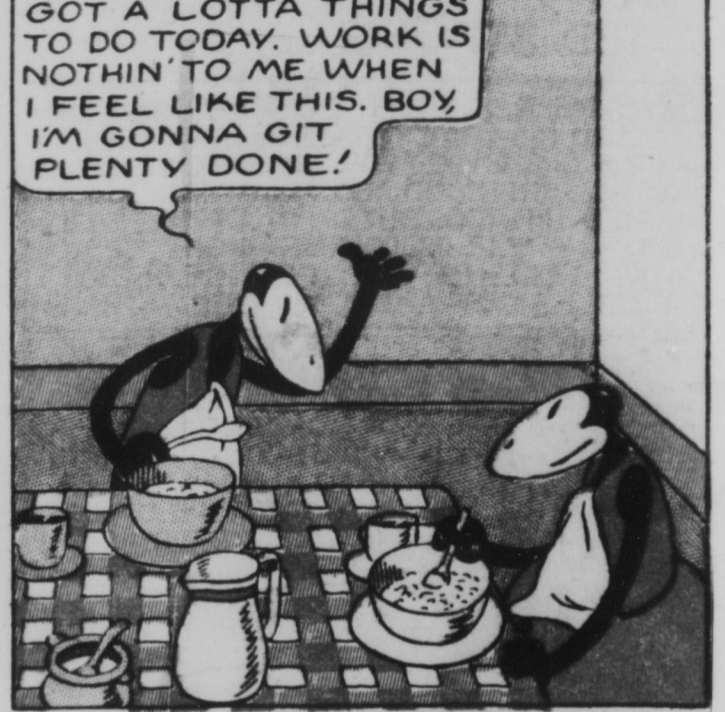

NO TIME.



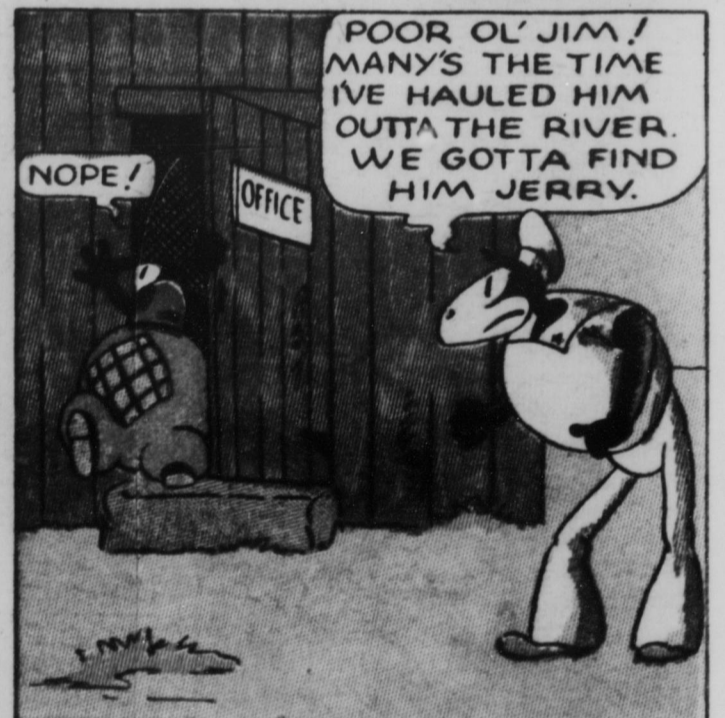
IT DON'T SEEM

GET TO WORK



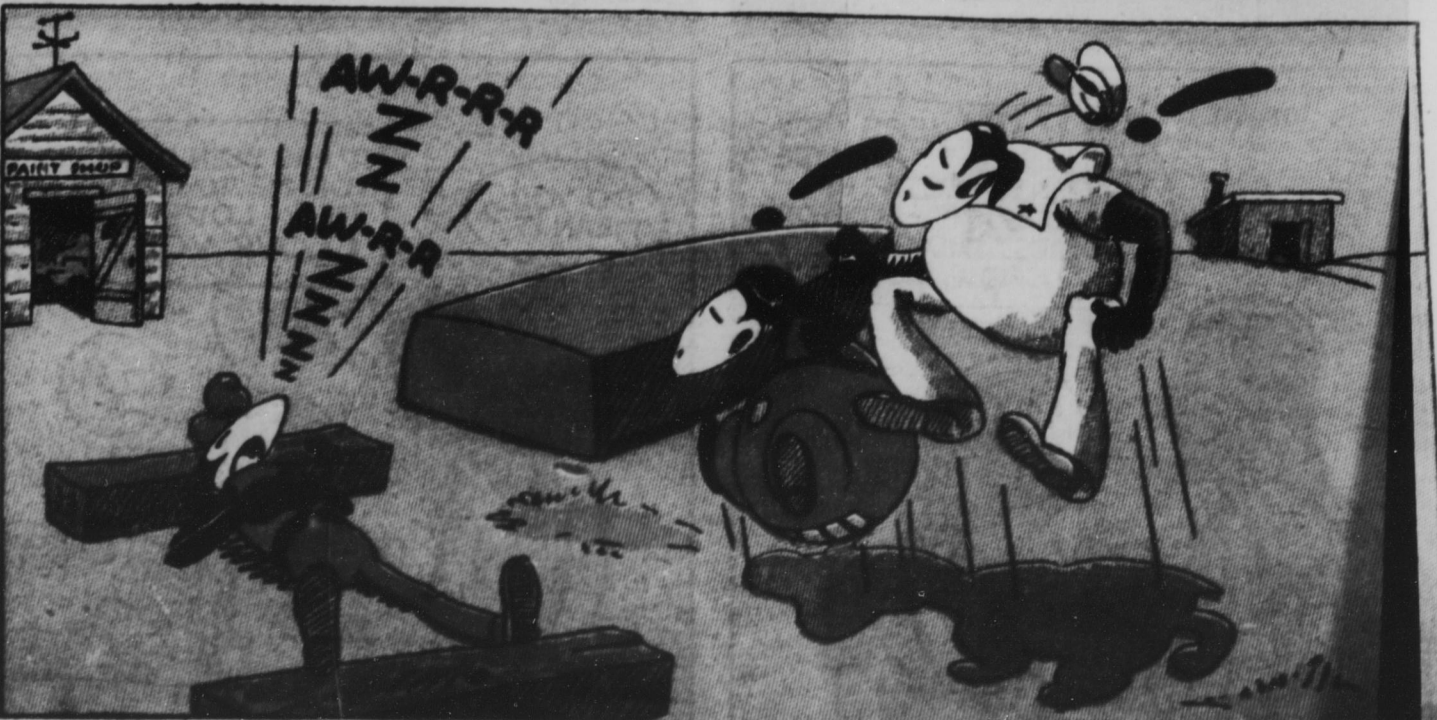
GOLLY, SKIPPER! I'M
