

AGAINST NEW DEAL

Selection of E. S. Dillard of Charlotte as State Manager and Treasurer of the Constitutional Democrats of North Carolina is announced, effective at once, marking the active beginning of "an aggressive state-wide educational campaign to defeat the New Deal and its philosophy of government."

Dr. Malcolm McDermott of Durham is State Advisory Director; J. E. Baker of Burlington, State Director of Finance, and L. D. Nuchols of Charlotte Assistant State Manager.

An organization, active and determined to bring out the maximum support of the movement at the polls Tuesday, November 7 will be formed in each of the 100 counties in North Carolina in the very early future, according to a spokesman.

"We have no quarrel with or criticism of the Democratic State ticket," said Mr. Dillard; "in fact it is our definite intention to support it in the forthcoming election. We do earnestly and sincerely appeal to all our citizens to join us in this conscience-based and spontaneous movement to defeat the forces arrayed against the best interest of our communities, our state, and our nation."

"In short, we appeal for the whole-hearted and practical support of all who favor constitutional government as opposed to the

group government from which 130,000,000 Americans now suffer so severely. The recently published Democratic Declaration of Independence forms a safe foundation on which to carry forward successfully this mighty movement."

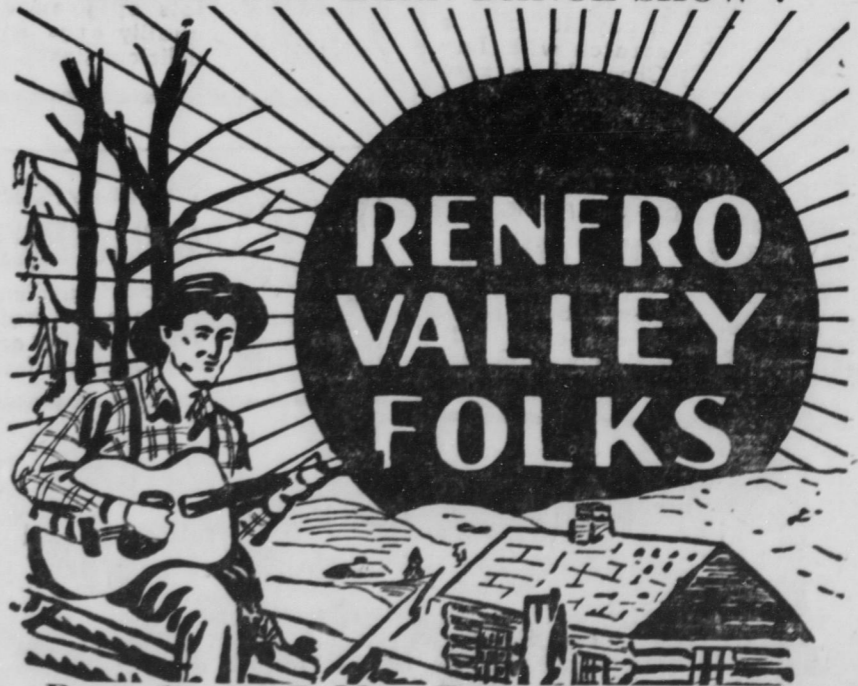
