

SALE OF FARM LAND

FIRST TRACT: Situate about one-half mile North of Rosenberg, and bounded on the North by the lands of Cash Williams, bounded on the East by the lands of Millard Stallings; bounded on the South by the lands of W. H. Chamblee; and bounded on the West by the lands of Henry Dunn's estate, and BEGINNING at a pine the Southeast corner of the dower land; thence North 20 2-5 poles to a stake; thence South

89 deg. E. 71 3-4 poles to a stake; thence South 57 4-5 poles to a stake in W. B. Chamblee's line; thence with the same North 89 deg. West 104 1-5 poles to a stake and pointers in the dower line; thence South 89 deg.
