

Philip R. Whitely of Wendell, lawyer, farmer, and businesman, announced his candidacy for the North Carolina House of Representatives from Wake County this week. Whitley, a former chairman of the Wake County Executive Committee, is the second man to announce his candidacy, James B. Little, Jr., Raleigh attorney, having announced last week.

Whitley is a veteran of World War II, having commanded an infantry company in Europe. He spent 45 months in service, receiving his discharge with the rank of captain. The Wendell man is a member of the Zebulon-Wendell American Legion Post.

"I shall make my stand known on issues as they arise," he said yesterday. "If elected, I pledge myself to serve faithfully all the Carolina."






