There will also be a district prize in which the winner of the Wake County contest will compete with the winners of Durham, Franklin, Granville, Halifax, Johnston, Nash, Orange, Vance, Warren, and Wilson Counties. The district prize \$10.00 cash; 4th prize \$5.00 cash; and 5th prize \$5.00 cash. This contest will be held in Henderson and is sponsored by the Henderson Chamber of Commerce.

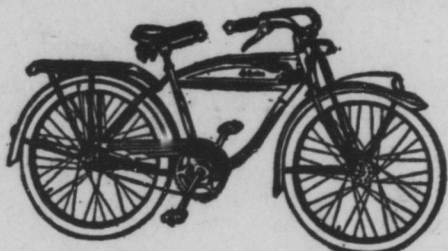
