

Bothth e number of milk cows and production of milk per cow increased in North Carolina from 1939 to 1944, reports C. Brice Ratcford, Extension Farm Management specialist at State Col-

A recent report by the Bureau of the Census shows that the number of cows increased by 33,515, or 11 per cent, and gollons of milk produced in creased from 143 to 161 million, or 12.6 per cent, Mr. Ratchford said.

However, there were 3.8 million pounds less butter churned in 1944 than in 1939, a decrease caused largely by extension of milk routes which have made a whole milk market available for more farmers, the specialist pointed out.

Mr. Ratchford saida study of the census shows that the number of cows per farm has increased. In 1944 there were fewer families with one cow than in 1939, but more families with two, three, and four cows. Almost twice as many families had five to nine cows in

The yield per acre for all types of tobacco grown in North Carolina increased from 655 pounds in 1929 to 1,142 pounds in 1946.


