

Revival at Pearces

Rev. J. A. McIver, head of the Mission Extension Department of Southwestern Baptist Theological Seminary in Fort Worth, Texas, will conduct a series of revival services at Pearce Baptist Church beginning Saturday, July 4, and continuing through the week, announced Rev. W. C. Blue, pastor of the Pearce and Bunn Baptist Churches.

Rev. McIver preached in more than 40 revivals in North Carolina during the 14 years of his ministry here. He last preached in the Lumberton Baptist Church in October 1946.

For six years he was pastor of the First Baptist Church of Louisville. His last service at Pearce Church was during the revival meeting in 1924 when fifty persons were received for baptism.

Plan Youth Week

The emphasis in the local Methodist Church next week will be on Children and Youth with the annual Vacation Church School being conducted each morning from 8:30 to 11:30, and a Youth Week held each evening from 8:00 until 10:00. 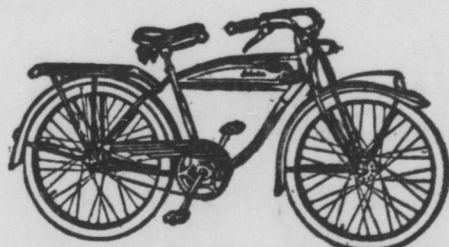
