The action was taken after the commissioners viewed with alarm the wars staged by young boys using airrifles as weapons. Several tragedies were barely averted as boys were hit on the face by the flying shot, and windows in buildings were broken during the pattles.

For any one convicted of violating the new ordinance, the punishment is severe: \$5.00 fine and 30 days on the roads or both for each offense.






