

Rev. R. H. Herring Tells Rotarians About "Old Fashioned" Christmas

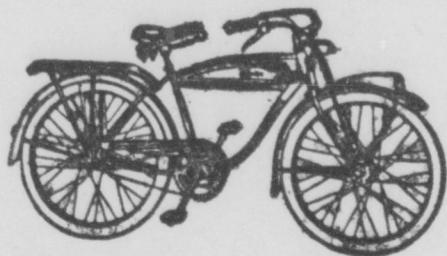
