Mitchell Leads Locals To 60-51 Cage Victory

Led by fast-stepping Carlton Mitchell and lanky Hilliard Greene, the Zebulon All-Stars staged a last quarter rally to topple the visiting Knightdale All-Stars 60-51 in a basketball game in the Wakelon gymnasium Wednesday night. Knightdale had overcome a 4-point halftime lead to pull ahead, 47-45, with less than five minutes left to play.

Coach Mitchell employed a two-team system, alternated the teams through the first three quarters. He started the Zebulon second-string, which held an 8-6 advantage when they left the floor at the end of the first quarter.

In the second quarter, the first team built up a commanding lead, which Knightdale whittled down in the third period, with Con-

way Haswell looping the ball through the net from all over the court.

In the final minutes Coach Mitchell poured goal after goal through the goal, running his total to 21 points for the night. Hilliard Greene was second for Zebulon with 15. Haswell scored 19 for Knightdale, and Ollie Wall netted 14.

This was the second game of the season for Zebulon, their first ending in a tie with Wake Forest after an overtime period in which the scorekeeper became confused.

A meeting will be held in Franklinton Monday night to organize a semi-pro league for this section, and Zebulon has been invited to send a representative. Other teams expected to join the league, which will be sponsored by three Lion's Clubs, are Wake Forest, Rolesville, Youngsville, Franklinton, and Creedmoor.

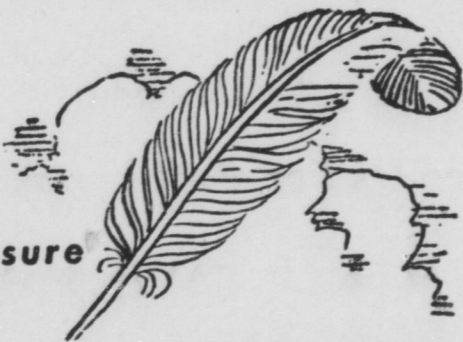

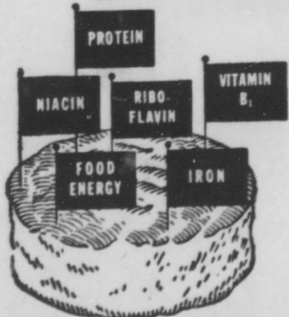
