## MURDER TRIAL

The case of F. W. Wilkinson, who is charged with murder in the first degree on account of the brutal slaying of his wife, and whose only explanation was that he "had been drinking," will be heard at 7:30 p. m. Wednesday, March 23, in the Wendell Methodist Church, according to an announcement by the pastor Rev. Paul Carruth. This will be a union service, in which the Zebulon Methodist Church and the Wendell Baptist Church will join. The story of an actual murder case will be presented in the form of a drama, "Prisoner at the Bar," in which twenty local residents

will have parts. Mr. A. R. House will act as presiding judge, while Mr. Fred A. Smith will serve as counsel for the defendant. Mr. Ray Whitley will act as sheriff, Mr. Howard Boling taking the part of the state fingerprint expert. Mrs. W. M. Fowlkes, Jr., will be an important witness for the prosecution. Miss Rachel Marshbourn will take the part of the prisoner's little daughter. Miss Martha Alice Renfro will act as clerk of the court, Mr. Shelton Bridgers will serve as bailiff.
