Hats with plumes, lace, flowers, ribbon, and whatever else you could buy, all held on by long, wicked-looking hatpins. Hightop button shoes. Pulley belts, Watches worn either on a pin with a hook, (a chatelaine), or on a long chain that went around the neck and through a fancy slide, the watch being tucked under the wearer's belt.
