

NOTICE OF SPECIAL BOND ELECTION AND SUPPLEMENTAL REGISTRATION
in the
TOWN OF ZEBULON, NORTH CAROLINA

A special bond election will be held between 6:30 a. m. and 6:30 p. m., Eastern Standard Time, on Tuesday, January 16, 1951, at which there will be submitted to the qualified voters of the Town of Zebulon the following question:

Shall an ordinance passed December 11, 1950, authorizing not exceeding \$50,000 Municipal Building Bonds of the Town of Zebulon for the purpose of providing funds for erecting and equipping a building for municipal purposes, including offices, courtroom, jail, and fire station, and acquiring a site therefor, and a tax for said bonds, be approved?

The question hereinabove set forth contains a statement of the purpose for which the bonds are authorized by the ordinance referred to in such question. If said bonds are issued a tax will be levied for the payment of the principal and interest thereof on all taxable property in said Town.

For said election the regular registration books for elections in said Town will be used, and such books will be open for the registration of voters, not theretofore registered, from 9 a. m. until sunset on each day beginning Saturday, December 23, 1950, and closing Saturday, January 6, 1951. On each Saturday during said registration per-

iod said books will remain open at the polling place. Saturday, January 13, 1951, is **Challenge Day**.

The polling place and the names of the election officers, subject to change as provided by law, are as follows:

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING \$50,000 MUNICIPAL BUILDING BONDS

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Commissioners of the Town of Zebulon:

Section 1. That, pursuant to The Municipal Finance Act, 1921, as amended, bonds of the Town of Zebulon, North Carolina, shall be issued in an aggregate principal amount not exceeding \$50,000 for

the purpose of providing funds for erecting and equipping a building for municipal purposes, including offices, courtroom, jail, and fire station, and acquiring a site therefor.

Section 2. That a tax sufficient to pay the principal and interest of said bonds shall be annually levied and collected.

Section 3. That a statement of the debt of the Town has been filed with the clerk and is open to

public inspection.

Section 4. That this ordinance shall take effect when approved by the voters of the Town at an election as provided by said Act.

The foregoing ordinance was passed on the 11th day of December, 1950, and was first published on the 15th day of December, 1950.

Any action or proceeding questioning the validity of said ordinance must be commenced within

thirty days after its first publication.

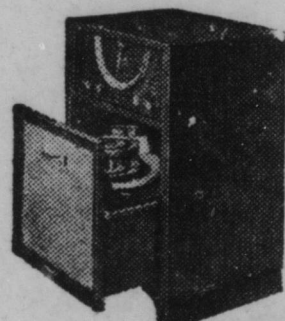
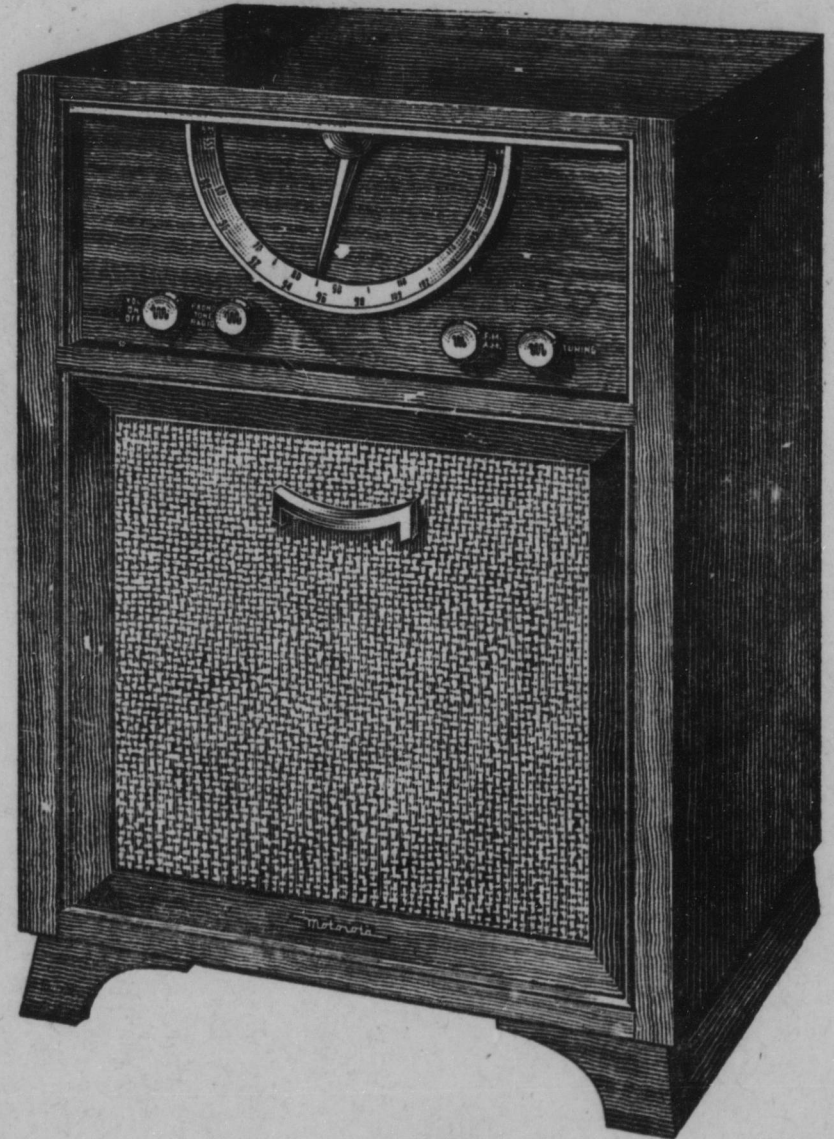

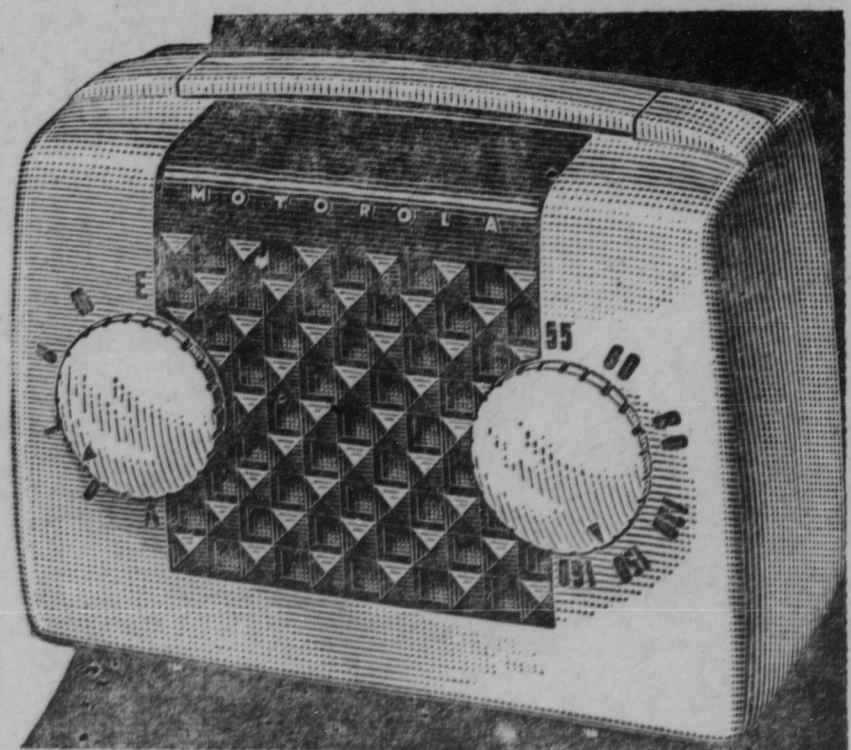
