depicted imaginary, contemporary designs, copies of master-pieces, and free hand subjects.

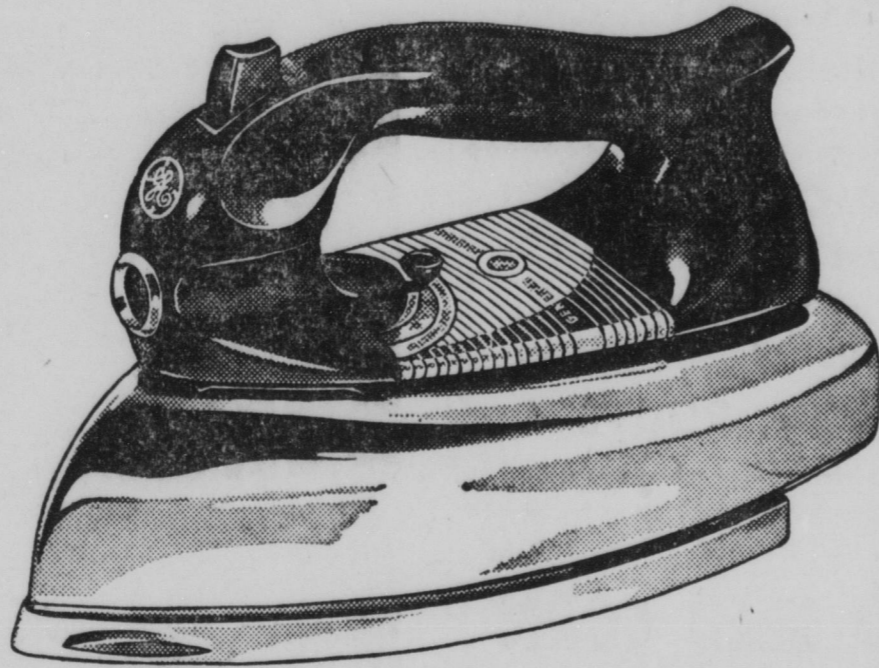
Complete works of individual students were also displayed in port-folios.
