Plant scientists are trying to breed into the lima bean the quality of resistance to downy mildew disease, a fungus infection that cuts yields. For this work they have assembled 113 foreign and domestic strains and varieties of lima beans.

A large number of hornworms have appeared in tobacco fields in Sampson county, according to County Agent E. J. Morgan.

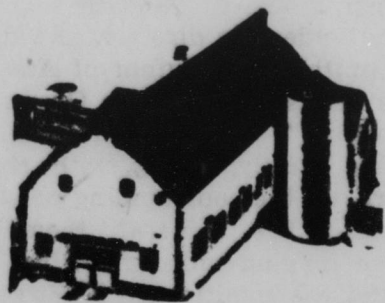
