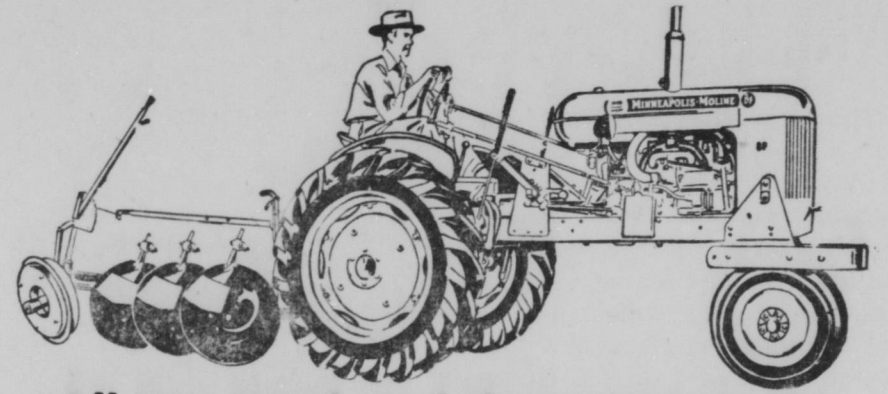

April 1st to June 5, Rabies Clinics, 1952

WAKE COUNTY

These clinics will be held at the following strategic locations in various parts of the country most convenient to the largest number of dog owners. The law provides that an opportunity be given all dog owners each year between April 1st. and June 30th. to have dogs vaccinated against rabies.

There is a penalty against each dog owner who fails to comply with this anti-rabic vaccination law. To prevent rabies, we must have some control measures and vaccinating is one of the important measures. Please note dates and places and be on time. A charge of \$1.00 will be made for each dog vaccinated, which will be refunded when you pay your taxes.
