**Northside Warehouse**

One of the fastest growing warehouses on the local market is the Northside, located on the corner of Cypress Street and Fourth Street.

Operated by Graham Dean, J. H. Sanders, Jr., and E. H. Price, this warehouse has become a sort of Mecca for farmers looking for courteous treatment and a fair price.

**Planters Warehouse**

Operated last year by the same management that conducts the Northside Warehouse, The Planters Warehouse will again be run by the trio of warehousemen associated with the warehouse, namely, Graham Dean, J. H. Sanders, Jr., and E. H. Price.

This warehouse is centrally located on the corner of Third Street and Pine Street, and is visited each year by a host of farmers who have come to expect courteous consideration and good prices for their tobacco at this house.

**Banner Warehouses**

Banner Warehouses No. 1 and No. 2, will again be under the management of the able and popular J. W. Dale, Jr.

During the years that this young warehouseman has operated on the Wendell Market, he has won a

large number of friends and a following of growers who number in the thousands.

The Banner houses are located just outside the limits of the Town on the old Raleigh-Wilson Road. Some of the highest averages on the local market have been made at the Banners.

**Star Warehouses**

J. S. Bernard and Curtis Walker operate the Star Warehouses No. 1 and No. 2 which are located on the corner of Third Street and Cypress Street.

The Star No. 1 is the oldest warehouse on the Wendell Market.

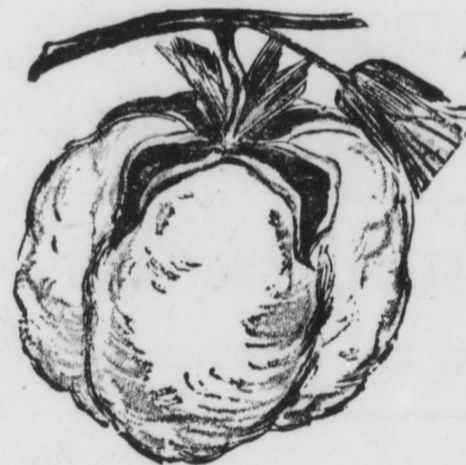
