# **Heavy Schedule Is Planned; Students** Speak at Churches

This afternoon at 4:30 one of the most interesting and educational weekends in Zebulon's history begins when "the World Comes to Zebulon." Forty-one foreign students attending the University of North Carolina, will arrive to spend a weekend in a small town to learn first-hand about America and Americans.

Citizens of the Zebulon community expect to increase their knowledge of other countries and their people through the close personal contact with their guests.

Thirty homes have volunteered to serve as hosts for the students, and will prepare breakfast and dinner on Saturday and Sunday for their guests.

The forty-one students come from sixteen countries scattered north and south of the equator on both sides of the globe.

The countries include Formosa, Philippines, Peru, Bolivia, China, India, Egypt, Israel, Japan, Pakistan, Thailand, Uruguary, Sweden, Kôrea, Colombia, and Lebanon,

Mayor Wilbur Debnam will welcome the visitors when they arrive this afternoon at the Zebulon Municipal Building. The Wakelon Band, directed by Alger Batts, will play as the students arrive.

Challie Iralu of India, president of the Cosmopolitan Club at the University, will introduce the guests to their hosts, and the students will be taken to homes where they will stay.

At 6:30 the Lions and Rotary Clubs will hold a joint meeting in the Wakelon cafeteria with the students and their hosts as guests.
