Some typical comments are found in a feature article which begins on page two.

The confidence appliance dealers have in their washers is indicated by a guarantee given with one line which reads:

"If any customer of an authorized (name) dealer buys and installs in her home a new 230 volt (name) Electric Dryer between January 28 and February 28, 1958, and within thirty days after installation tells the dealer that she is not completely satisfied with it,

the dealer will, immediately, upon release of the customer's title, arrange to have it removed and the purchase price of the dryer (exclusive of installation and other costs) refunded."

Other dealers have expressed similar confidence that owners will like their lines of washers and dryers.

In every line, 1958 models include improvements which make older models obsolete, and many washer owners are trading their older models in on new machines. As a result, there are some used machines in excellent conditions available.

This is a good season to purchase a washer and dryer, before the peak wash loads come later in the Spring. Prices are more attractive than ever, and the washers and dryers are waiting.

Here is a discouraging thought: unless the law of averages has been repealed, we are going to have an extra hot summer. Temperatures generally average about the same for a year, and it is going to take a lot of hot weather to bring our average temperature up to normal for 1958.

And as far as I am concerned (along with several hundred other local pipe-thawers), the hot weather will come none too soon. I promise here and now not to complain for the first three days of any hot spell we have this year. (After 3 days of heat, I may grumble a little, but right now I doubt it.)

We had the coldest weather last week that has ever been experienced in Zebulon. If anybody wants to argue that point with me, come to see me, and we will have it out.

But I have experienced much colder weather, but not through choice. In 1951 I walked over a lot of Kansas when the temperature was 20 below and there was a 30-mile an hour wind blowing. Man, that was really cold — about

like my wife's feet last Monday night.

The coldest temperature ever recorded in North America was at Snag, Yukon Territory, in 1947 when it got down to 81 below. Back in 1892 it got to 90 below in Siberia on three different days, and that is a world record. Maybe the IGY boys in Antarctica will come back with a new record. If they don't, they are missing a good chance.

The highest temperature ever recorded was near Tripoli in North Africa in 1922 — 136 degrees. Of course the meteorologists have never had their thermometers in a tobacco field in August.

But one of our farmers said that thinking of priming tobacco next summer was all that carried him through the cold spell.

When a man comments on the weather, however, he is just asking for trouble, unless he makes a remark like the following:

To Hold Assembly

"Jehovah's Witnesses of Circuit 26 will hold their first semiannual circuit assembly for 1958 in Elizabeth City the weekend of February 28 through March 2," so stated the presiding minister of the Zebulon Congregation, Raymond Parrish. The P. W. Moore High School will house the assembly.

Sessions will begin Friday evening at 6:45 and continue through Sunday until 6:00 p.m. The program will include problems and progress interspersed with skits and demonstrations.

The highlight of the convention will be a public talk by the district supervisor, James A. Thompson, Jr. The subject of the address will

be "Facing the Future Without Fear." All sessions will be open to the public.

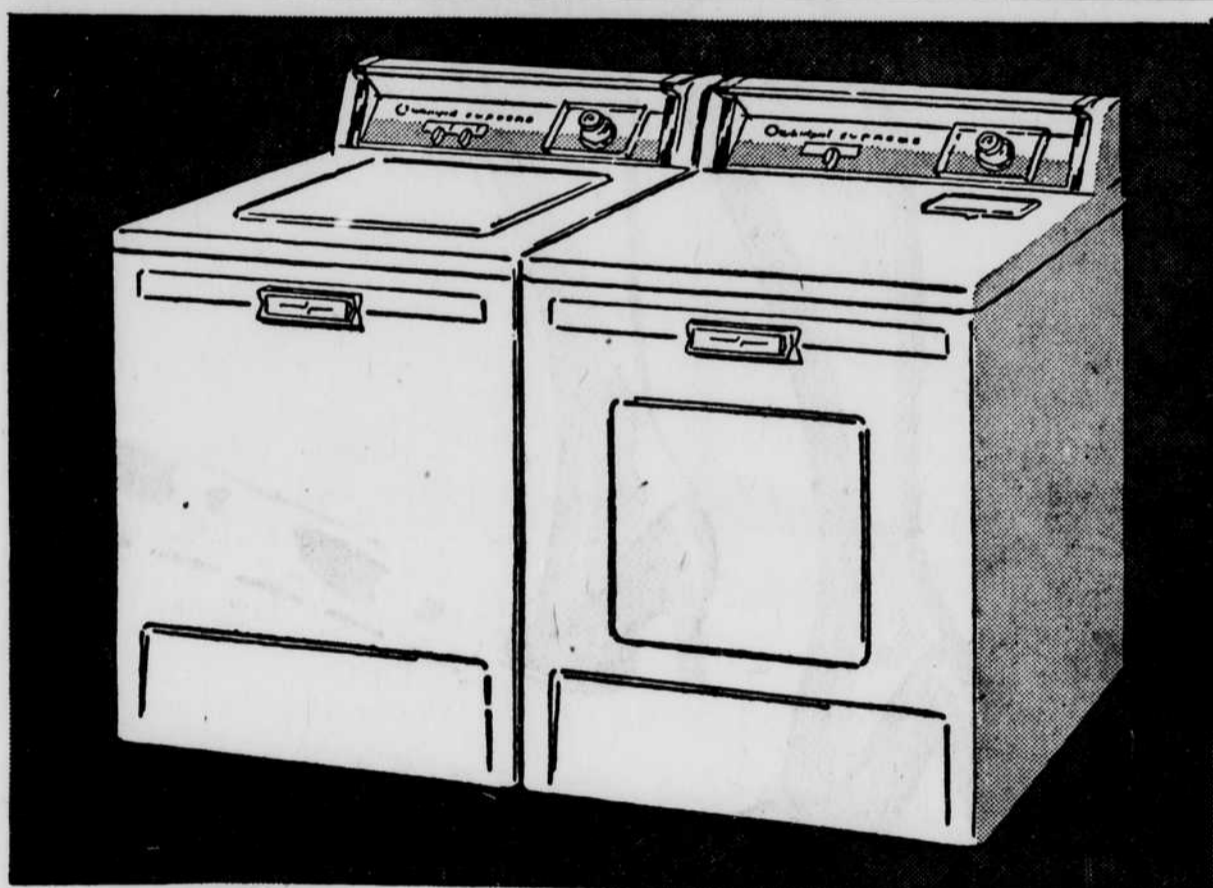
