Army Pfc. James H. Creech, Jr., 23, whose parents live on Route 1, Zebulon, recently participated in "Sabre Hawk," a Seventh Army maneuver which involved more than 100,000 troops in Germany.

The maneuver, designed to test the combat readiness of Seventh Army units, was the largest winter exercise ever held in Germany.
