Under and by virtue of the power of sale contained in a certain deed of trust executed by J. S. property conveyed in said deed of trust, the same lying and being in the Town of Zcbulon, Little River Township, Wake County, North Carolina, particularly described as follows:

First Tract.

Beginning at the Northwest corner of the intersection of Barbee Avenue and Whitley Streets, runs thence with Barbee Avenue North 65 degrees 30 min West, 50 feet to an iron pipe, corner of A. H. Pace lot; thence along the dividing line between A. H. Pace and J. W. O. Pace, parallel with Whitley St., North 24 degrees 30 minutes East, 250 feet to an iron pipe and Southern boundary of the Norfolk-Southern Railway right-of-way; thence along said right-o-way South 65 degrees 30 minutes East, 50 feet to an iron pipe in the Western boundary of Whitley Street; thence along the Western boundary of Whitley Street, South 24 degrees 30 minutes West, 250 feet to the point of beginning, being a lot 50 feet by 250 feet, said lot being the Eastern one-half of the first tract as described in a deed from the Zebulon Company to J. 
