Highlights Local "Operation Muster"

Captain Jack Potter, Jr., commander of Zebulon's Honest John Missile Battery, 113th Artillery, announces the opening of the National Guard's "Operation Muster" recruiting drive in this area.

The entire month of February has been designated as the period for "Operation Muster 1963" and the local unit will point to the observance of National Guard Muster Day of February 22, the birthday of George Washington.

"This is a very old tradition," says Capt. Potter, "and one which has a very special meaning this year. Muster Day dates back to an early colonial practice when it was the custom to hold an annual

muster of the Militia, usually on the village green, to see how many able-bodied men were available to bear arms in an emergency."

George Washington's birthday is of special significance to Guardsmen because he was one of the most outstanding citizen-soldiers of all time. He commanded a regiment in the Virginia Militia as a young man.

Young men who have passed their 17th birthday and who can meet the physical and mental standards can join the local Guard unit at the Zebulon Armory. "High school students," says Capt. Potter, "do not leave for six-months active duty training until after graduation."

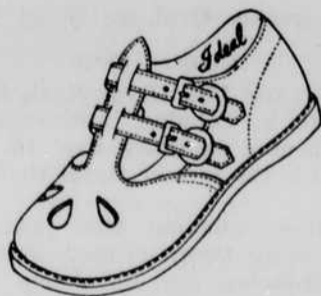

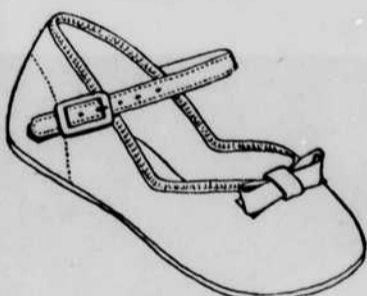
