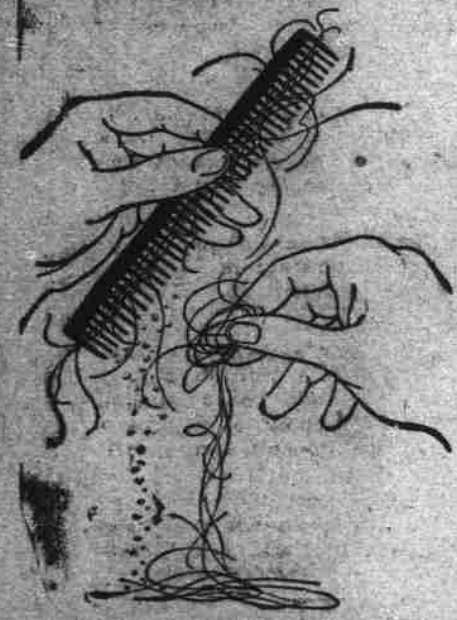

HEAVY LOSS IN FOREST FIRE

Harnett County Was Scene of Worst Single Forest Fire of the Season, Reported

ASHEVILLE, N. C., Nov. 29.—The most disastrous single forest fire of the season in North Carolina occurred in western Harnett county from November 22 to 25, according to word received by forestry officials here today. The flames enveloped 15,000 acres of timber, inflicting a damage estimated at \$20,000 through destruction of young tree growth and light wood. The local population and neighbors from Cumberland county under Fire Warden R. W. Christian responded to the call and at times as many as 250 people were combating the fire.

COTTON FUTURES
New York, Nov. 29.—Cotton futures opened steady. December, 25.25; January, 25.36; March, 25.39; May, 25.31; July, 25.01.

THE COTTON MARKET
New York, Nov. 29.—The cotton market showed renewed steadiness at the opening today. First prices were steady at an advance of 4 to 8 points and the market worked 11 to 19 points net higher after all, with January selling at 25.45.

THE STOCK MARKET
New York, Nov. 29.—Resumption of short covering operations, combined with better buying power on the long side resulted in a further advance in prices at the opening of today's stock market. Rail, food, tobacco and equipment shares were in greater demand, gains of 1 to 2 points being quite common. California Petroleum was one of the strong features, rising nearly 5 points. Foreign exchanges opened irregular.
