Washington People Now Soliciting Relief Fund

WASHINGTON, N. C., Dec. 7.—It was an earnest group of representative business and professional men who met in the court house at 10 o'clock this morning for the purpose of perfecting ways and means whereby all Washingtonians might be reached with a call of New Bern's needs in this hour of our neighbor's distress.

Having been appointed at the general call meeting issued by Mayor Sterling and meeting last night in the court house, Chairman W. C. Rodman called the meeting to order. Following a general discussion it was deemed best to block off Washington into nine districts and Wadesboro and Washington Park, making eleven. It was the unanimous opinion that a house to house canvass be made both in the business and residential sections.

Those making contributions of clothing, furniture, or anything that might be useful to our neighbors, in this time of need are urged to have articles ready to be called for by 8 a. m. Thursday. Agent Harold Myers notified Mayor Sterling during the meeting of the committees that the Norfolk-Southern would take all freight free of charge—extra crew if necessary. Crystal Ice Company's truck will call for bundles tomorrow morning.

The city has been blocked off into the following districts—the names of the committees soliciting the district follow: each district:

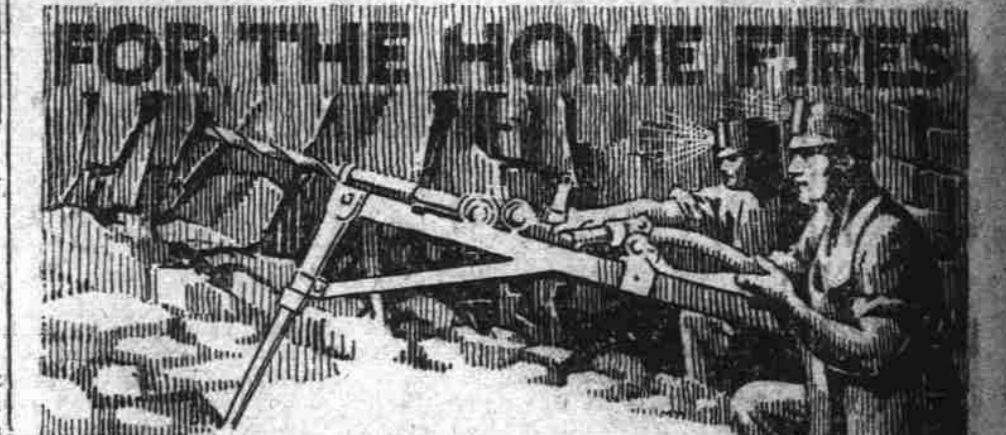
THE STOCK MARKET
NEW YORK, Dec. 7.—A buoyant tone developed in the stock prices at the opening of today's prices with food, oil, independent steel, merchandising and equipment shares in good demand. Early gains ranged from 1 to 2 points. Corn products and Coca-Cola led the advance in food shares, while Mexican Petroleum went up 3 and Standard Oil of New Jersey 2 1-2 points.

THE COTTON MARKET
New York, Dec. 7.—The cotton market opened steady at a decline of 1 to 8 points, owing to relatively easy Liverpool cables and reports of a continued dull trade in Manchester. There was a considerable Liverpool selling here during the early trading as well as scattering liquidation, but the offerings were absorbed by buying which showed a tendency to increase on declines and on selling of about 12 to 15 points net lower, the market steadied on covering.
