RESOLUTIONS

Adopted by the White Man's Club of Oak Ridge, Oct. 24th.

In view of the alarming condition of Eastern North Carolina under the rule of the constant increasing disposition of the negroes to band together, and their increasing insolence as has been shown right here among us during the last two days.

Resolved 1st. That we deem it the duty of every decent white man, regardless of his views on National politics, to come to the rescue of his race in this State.

Resolved 2nd. That we will not regard those white men who desert their race in this hour as worthy of as much respect as the negro who is at least faithful to the ties of nature and votes solemnly, thus indicating to white men everywhere their duty to stand with their race.

Resolved 3rd. That the solid vote of the negro ignorant as it is, and often led by vicious men, is equally a menace to the families of middle North Carolina, and that men that aid and abet this condition of things in this community should not be tolerated socially by white men.

Resolved 4th. That a copy of these resolutions be placed in the hands of every white man in this community and be widely read, and that we appeal to all as they love their wives and their families and their race to join our effort to redress in the State.

Resolved 5th. That the solid vote of the negro ignorant as it is, and often led by vicious men, is equally a menace to the families of middle North Carolina, and that men that aid and abet this condition of things in this community should not be tolerated socially by white men.

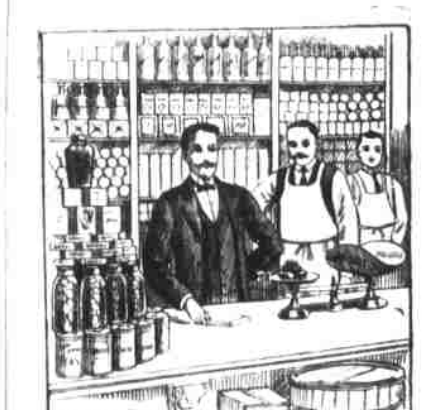


THE "CITY OF CHARLOTTE" FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE TWIN CITY HOSPITAL.
