Communists Attack Parties of Fascists While Passing Through a Workingman's Quarter of the City.

ONE PERSON KILLED; TWO OTHERS WOUNDED

Troops Now Occupy Trouble Zone and an Overwhelming Number of Soldiers Have Been Put on Duty.

Rome, Oct. 29, 8:15 p. m.—(By the Associated Press.)—Serious rioting broke out here tonight. Parties of fascists while passing through a workingman's quarter known to be a hotbed of subversive elements, were attacked by communists who threw stones and fired revolvers.
