### Mad Dog Ordinance

Owing to the large number of mad dogs

Owing to the large number of mad dogs running at large and to protect the school children and citizens from rabies, and to save the people from spending large sums of money and suffering the pain of taking the Pasteut treatment, be it therefore resolved by the Board of Aldermen of the City of Concord:

Section 1. That from the publication of this Ordinance and until November 1st, 1924, it shall be unlawful for any dog to run at large within the corporate limits of the City of Concord, or within one mile of said City limits, unless such dog shall wear d tag issued under authority of law showing that such dog has been vaccinated for rabies.

Sec. 2. Any owner of any person having under his control any dog, which shall permit his dog to run at large in violation of the provisions of this ordinance shall be guilty of a missiemeanor and upon conviction shall be fined Tventy-Five Dollars or imprisoned fifteen days, and any dog so found running at large not wearing the necessary tag showing that it has been properly vaccinated, will be killed by any policeman of the City.




