

Sophoulls Cabinet Resigns, It is Believed,

Athens, Oct. 1 (By the Associated Press).—The Greek cabinet headed by M. Pophoulls has resigned. The reason for the resignation has not been made known, but unofficially it is said to have been due to the withdrawal of the confidence of party leaders.

The political situation in Greece has been growing worse for some time, owing largely to inability of the party leaders to pull together and form a strong government.
