Baxter Shemwell is the Winner in Case Lodged by the City. Asheville Citizen.

Baxter Shemwell, 90 Merrimon Avenue, who was arrested Monday by a city police officer, on a charge of trespassing, was tried in city police court yesterday morning by City Police Judge McRae, and the City of Asheville paid the cost of \$6.65 assessed against Mr. Shemwell. Mr. Shemwell not only left the court room without paying any costs one fine, but is around \$70 better off financially as the result of his arrest, a city voucher for this amount having been issued.

Property on Merrimon Avenue, running back to another street is owned by Mr. Shemwell, according to his attorney, and he was assessed for a share in the paving for 60 feet. It appeared that 10 feet of this property belonged to W. F. Maxwell and only 50 to Mr. Shemwell, but the latter had thought it his own as he had paid the assessment.

The city engineer testified that the fault was mainly with the City of Asheville. However, Judge McRae taxed the costs on a charge of simple trespassing and this was later paid by the city. Mr. Shemwell was given a refund, amounting to around \$70, on the 10 feet of paving in front of the property that he did not own.
