GIFT PARCEL SUBSIDIES TO EUROPE ARE ENDED

Washington — Special subsidies on U. S. gift parcels to a large part of Europe expired this week and the bargain rate of six cents per pound was replaced with the regular rate of 14 cents.

The difference had been paid to the Post Office Department by the Economic Co-operation Administration. Because of economic improvement, the subsidy is being discontinued to Britain, Northern Ireland, the Netherlands, Corsica, France and the Western zones of Germany and Berlin.

It continues to Italy, Austria, Greece, Trieste, China, Korea and Japan.

About 20 million acres of land are under irrigation in 117 Western states.

Proposals received after the hour and date specified above will not be considered.

Separate bids will be received for the General Contract, the Electrical Contract, the Plumbing Contract and the Heating and Ventilating Contract.

Complete plans, specifications and contract documents will be open for inspection at the office of the Owner and in the office of the Architect, Lindsey Madison Gudgeon, 52 Carter Street, Asheville, N. C. Plans, specifications, and other contract documents may be obtained by prime contractors upon deposit of \$50.00 in cash or check, for General Contract; \$50.00 in cash or check for Plumbing, Heating and Ventilating, Electrical Contracts. The full deposit will be returned to contractors submitting bona fide proposals, provided plans and specifications are returned to the Architect in good condition within five days after the date set for receiving of bids. Subcontractor's deposits will be refunded less cost of printing and handling.

All contractors are hereby notified that they must have proper license under the State laws governing their respective trades.

Each proposal shall be accompanied by a cash deposit, or by a Certified Check drawn on and certified by some bank or trust company insured by the Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation, in an amount equal to not less than 5 per cent of the proposal; or in lieu thereof a bidder may offer a Certified Check of 2 per cent of the bid plus a bid bond of 3 per cent of the bid; said deposit to be retained by the Owner as liquidated damages in event of failure of the successful bidder to execute the contract within ten days after the award, or to give satisfactory surety as required by law. (Public Laws 1933, Section 1, Chapter 400, General Statutes of North Carolina, 1943, C 143 Art. 8 S. 129).

Performance Bond will be required in amount of one hundred per cent (100 per cent) of the contract price.

Payment Bond will be required in amount of fifty per cent (50 per cent) of the contract price.

Payment will be made on the basis of ninety per cent (90 per cent) of the monthly estimates and final payment made upon completion and acceptance of the work.

No bid may be withdrawn after the scheduled closing time for the receipt of bids for a period of thirty days.

The following will supercede Paragraph 13. **BID GUARANTEES**, of the General Conditions, Section 1:

13. **BID GUARANTEES.** Bids shall be accompanied by a bid guarantee of not less than five per cent (5 per cent) of the amount of the bid, same to be in the form of a certified check or cashier's check in the sum of two per cent (2 per cent) of the amount of bid PLUS a bid bond in the sum of three per cent (3 per cent) of the amount of bid, or certified check in the sum of five per cent (5 per cent) of the amount of the bid, made payable to the Owner. Checks as herein called for shall be drawn on a bank which is insured by the Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation, and the certification shall be by the bank on which the check is drawn. Such bid bond and check, or check, shall be submitted with the understanding that it shall guarantee that the bidder will not withdraw his bid for a period of thirty days after the scheduled closing time for the receipt of bids; that if his bid is accepted, he will enter into a formal contract with the Owner in accordance with the Form of Agreement included as a part of the Contract Documents, and that the required performance and payment bonds will be given; and that in the event of the withdrawal of said bids within

said period, or the failure to enter into said contract and give said bonds within ten (10) days after he has received notice of the acceptance of his bid, the bidder shall be liable to the Owner for the full amount of the bid guarantee as representing the damage to the Owner on account of the default of the bidder in any particular hereof. The bid bonds and checks shall be returned to all except the three lowest bidders within three (3) days after the formal opening of bids. The remaining bid bonds and checks will be returned to the three lowest bidders within 48 hours after the

Owner and the accepted bidder have executed the contract and the executed Performance and Payment bonds have been approved by the Owner, and the required proof of carriage of the insurance necessary.
