

An Official Brigand.

The accounts of the indictment against Signor Nasi, former Italian minister of instruction, have just been published. From the beginning of his official life until the end of it, a period of two years, Nasi apparently considered the belongings of the educational department, as well as of the government treasury, his own private possessions. When orders were given for the account of the ministry Nasi at the same time gave orders for objects of personal use; furniture, cutlery, flowers, a telephone, tea service, watch, carpet, statues, etc., which were to be delivered to him and charged to the department. He paid a sculptor \$100, and a painter \$1,000, for a statue and portrait of himself, and for photographs of his family and friends he paid a firm no less than \$300, all of which was charged to the department.—Public Opinion.
