Sales were very light in the piedmont markets, being 616,628 at WinstonSalem and 461,698, at Durham The total amount of the sales at all the points covered by the report was $28,727,627$. COTTON SPINERS FOR CURTALL

- Action Means That the Five Million Spindles Will Soon Be Runniag on Short Time or Remain Idle.
Charlotte, Oct. 8. - The board governors of the American Manufacturers' Association to day adopted e resolution favor ing a general curtailment that will effect eyery spin $1 l e$ and loom in every mill numbered among those represented in the membership of the organization.
The curtailment resolutions are as follows:
"That in view of the disparity now exhisting between the price cotton and cotton goods, we. Resolved 1. That a committee of five be appointed to formulate a curtailment agreement

2. That we recommend every mill which is in position to do so, to sign this agreemen and enter upon curtailment until the price of goods become on a parity with the price of cot-
Signed, Lewis Parker, W. A. Erwin, D. A Thompkins, committee.
Taken in its least significant aspect, the resolutions adopted to-day mean that something like five millign spindles will be running on short tinfe of will be completely idle within a few weeks, or at such time as the committee appointed to draw up the contract of curtailment shall determine. This committe of five provided for by the resolutions has in its hand the most crucial part of the questions to settle, that is to what extent and how low shall the curtailment be made effective.
Over Atlanta, Memphis, Rich mond, Asheville and several other cities, Charlotte was un animously chosen as was unplace or meeting, when the 14th annual convention of the Ameri can Cotton Manufacturers will take place here May 25 th and 26th, 1910.
