

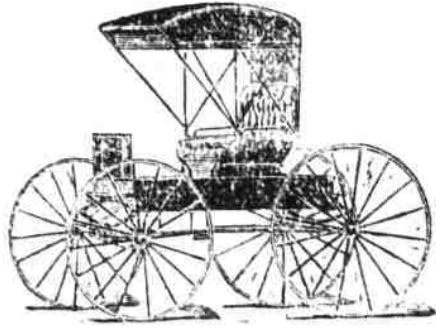
PERSON SUPERIOR COURT

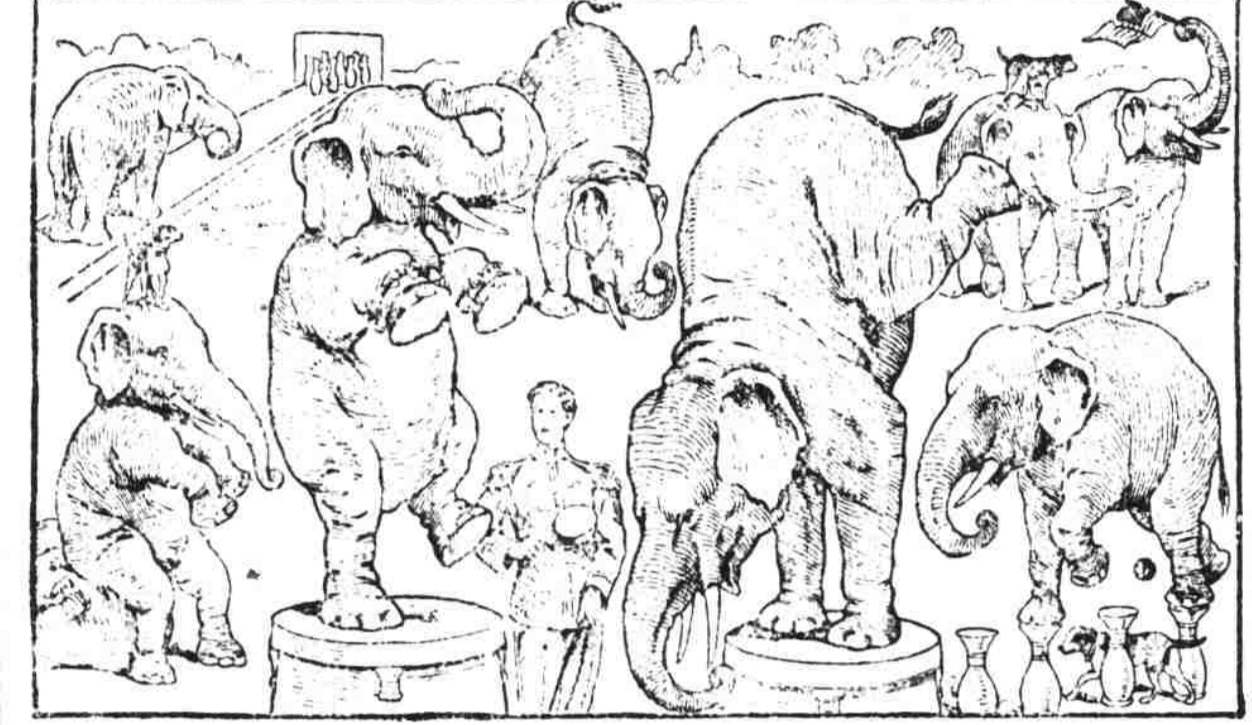

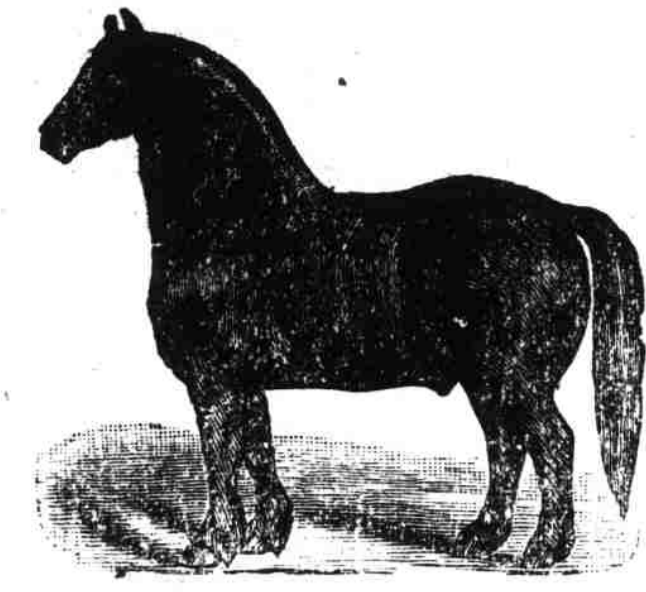
