## AWOONCRHENT TO OIR CISTOMERS

Due to the fact that all insurance companies doing business in this state are strictly requiring a settlement from agents not less than 60 days from date of policies the local insurance agents of High Point find it necessary to put their business on a better basis with regard to extension of credit. The abuse of extending credit probably has been worse in the insurance business than in any other line, although this has been largely due to the failure of the agents themselves to collect premiums promptly.

To correct this situation, the Local Insurance, Agents of High Point have adopted a uniform plan for the collection of Fire and Casualty Insurance premiums. It is felt that the insuring public will see the justice and wisdom of this course and will gladly lend their hearty co-operation.

Beginning October I all Fire insurance and Casualty premiums will be due on the date the policies are written. When necessary, however, an extension of credit will be allowed on the following basis:

[^0]Policies outstanding on which premiums have not been paid after the expiration of this time will be cancelled. Complete statements of account will be sent totall customers promptly and ample notice will be given before any contract is cancelled.
This plan is now being used in a large number of cities and towns in this section of the country and to the entire satisfaction of both agents and customers.
It is the aim of the Local Agents of High Point to render real serv. ice and protection to Policyholders, and it is believed that the operation of this plan will enable Agents to serve their customers to better advantage.
