POSTAL TELEGRAPH.
Hon. S. S. COX sends us a copy of the speech recently delivered in the House by Hon. CHARLES A. SUMNER, of California, on the postal telegraph. He offered an amendment to the bill making appropriations for the Postoffice Department, providing for the erection of telegraphic lines to every town within the United States containing a population of four hundred inhabitants, or more, and also providing for the beginning of each State for it to begin, taking New Berne as the starting point in North Carolina.

In arguing the Constitutional power of Congress, Mr. SUMNER shows very clearly that the establishment of a postal telegraph is not a "paternal government" than did the system that resulted in strapping the mail bags on the post boy's pony, that afterwards transferred them into the boot of the mail coach, that finally tossed them into the van of the railway. His argument is, and it appears to be an unanswerable one, that the postal telegraph is just another step in the line of progress, being nothing more than a more rapid method of carrying the letters of the people, and that Congress has already unimpairedly exercised the power.

Mr. SUMNER is a progressive man. We agree with him that the Congress has neglected to perform its duty when it fails to give the greatest possible speed of intercommunication to the people of these States. We beg to remind him that many communities do not have the post boy's pony of former times, and we wish to call his attention to the fact that notwithstanding Hyde county is nearer than a hundred miles of this city, and that a large portion of its produce is handled in this market, it takes about ten days for the merchant here to communicate with his people by letter. We join him in this forward movement and hope not only to have the postal telegraph but have the post boy's pony to quicken his pace and visit every neighborhood at least three times a week.

In closing his speech Mr. SUMNER, while he claimed the measure was non-partisan, pointed out the reason why SAMUEL J. LILEY was not inaugurated President of the United States. He said it was generally believed that in the event of LILEY'S inauguration, M. M. BERRY would have been President-General, and it was well known that he was unpopular with the people of the State. He said that the Indiana Democrats, in connection with the non-partisan party of the Republicans of this State, were organizing for the purpose of seeing that LILEY was inaugurated, and a flood of disparaging reports from that State, from every corner of the Commonwealth, had been everywhere disseminated, and that they were "bush" of these reports, and that the great majority of the voters of that State, who divided between LILEY and BERRY, this is a new point in the argument, but possibly there is something in it.
