such a line would result in a dead loss in operation. The sleeping car people admit, however, that a very small proportion of travelers buy a whole section in order to secure more room and air. The traveler was is shut into a box 6x2x4 when he may just as well enjoy the comfort of free circulation of air above him, by no means see the matter in the same light as do the railroad companies. He is needlessly deprived of physical comfort for a purpose that is blackmail. It does not cost the airoad company a cent to give him the fre h air which he craves. To say that he shall not have it is precisely the same as it would be for the railroad company to decree that he shall not occupy a full double seat in a day coach when no one calls for the second half of it. It would pany to require the payment of two fares for the use of a double seat in the day time, when a car is not full, than it is to deprive a passenger of air and space which are not in use on a sleeing car. In the former case, the passenger rets just as much air and alm st as much ease in occupying a single seat as he dies in filling a double one. But
