



Howard Crosby was born in New York February 27, 1829. He was a son of William Bedlow Crosby, the phi anthropist. He was graduated at the University of the City of New York in 1844, and Legame professor of Greek there in 1851. In 1859 he was called to the chair of Greek at Rangers. Two years later he entered the ministry of the Presbyterian Church, and magnel the duties of pas for of the First Coureb, of New Brunswick with those of the professorship. In 1863 he gave up work at New Brunswick to become pastor of the Lourte Avenue Presbyteria Thurch, in New York city, which place I held at the time of his death. He also held he office of chancellar of the University of New York from 1870 until 1881, and has been since 1861 a member of its council. he received the degree of D. D. from Harvard, in 1871 that of LL, D. from Columbia College. He was chosen moderator of the General Assembly of the Presbyterian Church of the United States in 1875, and has often been a delegate to that body. In 1877 he was a gate to the first Presbyterian General Council
