Washington, Aug. 2.—The new law which has started for the new gold commission to make a thorough investigation and report just what he will do with the government intended buyers.

Commission houses had extensive buying orders and prices under the leadership of the Grangers advanced steadily, making new records.

The industrial class was strong. Chicago Gas advanced two points upon the final arrangement of consolidation. Sugar and tobacco advanced upon inside buying.

The market is on the up grade now. Cotton, Liverpool came strong with a good demand. Insiders were disposed to sell to buyers on good crop reports, and large crop estimate, with little demand from spinners.

The reaction caused a decline of 7 to 16 points.

When was higher on foreign cables and the engagement of over one million bushels for export with St. Louis bidding for all new wheat receipts caused new records in wheat. Both options gained nearly two cents.

A reaction may come, but the farmer will get better prices for years if he holds his wheat.

New York, July 31.—The week ends with some concession in stocks from the highest prices made. This has been effected by a sentiment which believes that a reaction was done. The closing prices were the lowest of the day.

With the immense crops in sight and good prices for cereals railway earnings will prove effective and railway securities will advance much higher.

Cotton statistical position is the strongest since 1890, with prices nearly 4 cents a pound lower. Total visible supply one hundred and ninety thousand bales less compared with last year. With general business improvement and with spinners demand increasing, although a big crop is expected, prices will be well maintained.

Wheat on final liquidation of the July option and liberal receipts and an expected million bushels increase in the visible supply for the week caused a decline today. Foreigners continue large buyers to the coast as parties coming back say that the heat here is terrible.

PHOENIX, Ariz., Aug. 3.—M. E. Anderson, a broker, with office at 50 Wall street, New York, died of thirst and exposure in the desert north of Phoenix, last night. His wife is at a farm house near the city in a critical condition.

The couple had started to visit their son on Cave creek, thirty miles north of Phoenix. Missing the road they drove aimlessly about the desert.

A passing teamster saw the crooked tracks of the vehicle and followed them several miles, finding the couple just in time to save M. Anderson's life. M. Anderson was too far gone to drink, was thirsty, which the teamster offered, and he soon died.
