PENITENTIARY LEASE.

Question Under Discussion by the Board of Directors.

Chamber of Commerce Officers, Marble Industry Very Active, Tule Industry, Threat to Repeal Charter, Low Price Cotton Discourages Farmers.

The board of penitentiary directors met again last night to discuss the possibility of leasing the penitentiary.

The offer of the syndicate of North Carolinians was refused and the offer of the syndicate represented by Mr. John H. Winder was considered.

Mr. Winder was considered, Governor Russell approved of the offer with several amendments. He said the control and custody of the convicts must remain with the State agents.

That the superintendent and board of directors must look after the regulations of the management of the convicts and appoint the guards etc.

That the contract shall be for the salary of superintendent and clerks. The board has to be kept in order by the contractor. A bond with good security to be given.
