## ASKING FOR MORE.

North Carolina Negroes Call 2  
Convention for Nov. 3d.

Grievances Set Forth in an Address  
They Demand the Offices that  
They Think Their Votes Entit  
Titled Them to Result  
of Fusion.

Editorial Note:

BALTIMORE, Oct. 16.—A very  
interesting document signed by the  
Negroes in this state, to be held at the  
city November 3d.

The object of the convention is to  
set forth the various grievances, and to  
decide officially the course to be  
taken by the Negroes.

This address is issued by what the  
convention decided states, that the people  
of North Carolina are numbered and  
various thousand voices in favor of their  
share, one State clock, with a  
salary of \$1,000 and to a proportion  
making a total of but \$1,500.

In contrast to this, the address states  
the white Republicans and the People's  
are putting one million six hundred and  
one thousand dollars in offices.

The negroes issuing the document all  
well known among that race. The ad  
dress concludes with the following ex  
pression towards the white members of  
their party. "These fellows are simply  
making foolish and fatiguing at our  
expense."

The text of the note of Secretary Sher  
man to Governor Hastings of Pennsyl  
vania, confirms the statement that the
