New Paper to be Started in Republicans May Desert Tracy for Mayor of Chicago and Then
Raleigh Nov. 15th. the Union Candidate.

Hundred Democrats Coming.

JOURNAL BUREAU, NEW BERNE, N. C., OCT. 27. The new morning Democratic daily will appear by 8 o'clock. It will be "strictly Democratic" and some of the most prominent Democratic business men in the State will be stockholders. The capital is \$20,000, one fourth of which is taken in this city.

This morning a sad accident occurred here. Cadet Sam Watt attempted to board a street car to get his duties at the A. & M. college, when by some unknown way he was thrown on the track and badly injured. He may lose his foot. He was carried immediately to the Hospital, so that he might have every attention. Thus the accidents by street car increase.

George has caused the veteran Senator Croker and his supporters to say on what word of favor the Tammany leaders into an excited state. Mr. Stone wrote that Bryan had refused to say a word in support of the Tammany ticket.

The statement issued last night by Senator Platt, in which he declared that Tracy was certain of election, failed to have the intended effect of stiffening up the machine line. Even Platt's close friends in addition to it say merely that no good general will admit defeat on the eve of battle.

Admiral General Stewart will issue orders to start work on 12,000 Pennsylvania sledges for free transportation to Chattanooga and return. The work will be

done under contract with the Chinese. The Chinese government has received a large sum of money and the rebels. It is stated that a resolution to recognize the independence of the Chinese, which is supported by most members will be introduced into the Congress of Argentina.

President McKinley received Dr. Samson, who explored the blue room of the White House. With him were four members of the Cabinet, secretaries Sherman, Gage, Long and Wilson. In Samson was accompanied by the White House by the Swedish Minister.

Chief of Police Ripley of the navy issued an order discharging from the force five hundred and thirty-four policemen and appointing in their places a like number of Democratic ex-policemen, who had been discharged under the previous administration.

Nearly all the vessels in the Behring Sea whaling fleet have been caught in the ice and some of them may not last through the winter. Not since the winter of '84 has such wholesale disaster been threatened.

The city of Denver, Colo., is in the grasp of one of the worst blizzards ever known there. The storm began with a blinding fall of snow, accompanied by a high wind, and it continued today with increased fury. The blizzard is general throughout the eastern section and part of the northern section of that state, the southern part of Wyoming, the northeastern part of Utah, the western part of Nebraska and Kansas, and also in South Dakota.
