JOURNAL BUREAU, Raleigh, N. C., Feb. 9. — The State Board of Health is making good progress with the analysis of the water supply in the various towns and cities in the State.

The usual report of the labor commissioner will give the first statistics as to the fishing industry in the State. There were caught in the eastern waters during 1897, 142,326,000 fish, valued at \$1,587,600; 78,000 barrels of clams, worth \$27,000; 35,000 turkeys and turtles, worth \$19,000; shrimp and crabs, \$8,000; oysters, valued at \$160,000, value \$5,000. There were employed 12,000 and 3,800 vessels and boats, 124,000 gill nets were used.

There has been found one man in the State that endorses D. J. Russell as governor. He is from Moore county and considers Russell one of the safest and best leaders the republicans ever had. No position in the gift of the government can be found good enough with which to reward this fanatical friend of his.

Six pension warrants written for this county are unclaimed, one an old soldier, W. J. Blann, and the other four are widows. Barten, Wilson, Phillips, Weends are Glendon. If they have moved to another county their warrants can be transferred and the money \$15.70, be sent them, otherwise the list will be marked "unclaimed" and returned to the Treasurer.

Before the U. S. court yesterday, ex postmaster Shaffer was sued on his official bond for the sum of \$28.92, for he was short in his accounts. The court gave judgment against him and his bondsmen. Governor Russell is one of the bondsmen. Ex Marshal Carroll was also sued for two barrels of whiskey placed in his care, and which cannot now be found. They were valued at \$141. Judgment was granted against him.

A. S. Lusk and J. A. Smith are here as a committee from the directors of the N. C. R. R. to audit the expense account as regards the suit to annul the lease of the road to the Southern. Attorney's fees are about \$25,000 and other expenses are about \$85,194.
