Wants to Be Treasurer North
Carolina Railroad.

Chambers Smith For Election Expected
to Be Ordered Away. Railroads
Cannot Tell of Movements of

The Legislature passed a bill giving the
State Treasurer authority to duplicate any
sum of money raised in the year for
a special public school fund up to
\$50,000. No more county to be paid over
\$500. So far the Treasurer has paid out
to meet these demands \$6,236.41.

DO NOT AGREE.

Senate and House Still Apart at
a Late Hour.

Resolution Goes Back and Forth.
Senate Yields the Recognition
Clause, Two Houses May
Concur Before Finally
Adjourning.

Washington, April 28, 10:30 p. m.
The two Houses of Congress are in
session and have not yet come to an
agreement.

The Cuban resolution passed by the
Senate is composed of the House lead-
ing, the Senate promptly, Senate, result-
ing, the Cuban resolution and a fourth
section composed by Mr. Teller declar-
ing any intention of the United States
to control or exercise sovereignty over
the island.

The first section reads as follows:
"That the people of the island of Cuba
are, and at all times shall be free and
independent, and that the government of
the United States hereby recognizes the
people of Cuba as the true and lawful
government of that island."

The House refused to concur in this
section by a vote of 149 to 135, and
struck out the part recognizing the
people of Cuba, and also the two words
"and also."

The resolution going back to the
Senate, Chairman Davis of the
Foreign Relations Committee moved
in the House amendment. This
motion was defeated by a vote of 161 to
122. The resolution then went to the
conference committee of the two Houses.

Contrary to the general impression
the conference committee of the House
and Senate failed to agree upon the
resolution as amended in the House.

The Senate yielded the recognition
clause, but refused to concur
including out the words "and also,"
and still refused to concur in the
House amendment on a 50-40 vote.

The Senate then by a vote of 67 to 43
refused to agree to another conference
committee and then took a recess of one
hour to await the further action of the
House. The conference committee
will meet again tomorrow afternoon.
