THE REVOLUTION SHOULD CEASE.

After about three years of political revolution in North Carolina, and with the Democrats occupying all points of vantage, it would seem time for a cessation of the turmoil which has filled every section of the State.

That the majority of the people are tired of political revolution, no one will question who gets away from the political leaders, and talks with the plain living citizen.

But before the Democratic Legislature has touched upon vital matters of State interest, of affairs which unless determined by the present Legislature, will leave North Carolina in financial distress, with none of the Democratic promises fulfilled, there is brought up again a political revolution, which if persisted in, will do away with all practical legislation during this session and shatter the Democratic party in the State.

The bill to impeach Associate Justices Furches and Douglas, seems to have for its introduction more political inspiration than reason or common sense.

The paltry sum of eight hundred dollars, the amount of Shell Fish Combs, slanders White's claim, which was paid through the Supreme Court's mandamus, and upon this action the bill for impeachment is based, is too insignificant a sum for Faircloth, Furches and Douglas to have committed themselves, and sacrificed honor and reputation.

Hence it must appear preposterous that these gentlemen of the Supreme Court of the State, should have acted hastily, unadvisedly or been governed entirely by partisanship.

But this bill of impeachment what is its motive? Is it to sustain the authority of Legislature enactment, or does there seem a possible loop hole to secure two political offices through coercion, or by alarming the Associate Justices' threats?

Without taking up the constitutional duty of the authority upon which Messrs. Faircloth, Furches and Douglas issued the mandamus, it is impossible to believe that their action lays them open to impeachment, that is impeachment based upon the ground that these gentlemen openly and flagrantly violated their oath of office.

Messrs. Faircloth, Furches and Douglas have often been held in low political favor and frequently denounced by non-discriminating political news papers, but for a Legislature to impeach them, is quite a different matter, it is a most serious affair, and one which can work incalculable injury to a State's reputation, and carry ruin to the party instituting such an action.

North Carolina has had enough of political revolution. The people were promised quiet and peace, but the present impeachment proceedings threaten to again bring disorder among the people at home, and further discredit the State abroad.

Let political resolutions cease in North Carolina, or the people will lend a hand, which will place in power a party that will give the State a rest from these ceaseless political upheavals.

The people are getting tired of political persecutions, or anything which smacks of them.
