**Notice to all Ex-Confederate Soldiers.**

The new pension law passed by the General Assembly at the session 1901 provides pensions for all soldiers or sailors who served in the late war between the States and to widows who were married before the 1st day of April 1865 to said soldiers or sailors and have not remarried since his death. Applications for pensions must be made in person, to the County Board of Pensions on or before the 1st Monday in July 1901. This applies to all who are now drawing pensions, as well as to those who desire to be placed on the list. No one will be allowed pensions who does not file his or her application according to law. No deferment will be allowed a pension. Blank applications can be had by applying to the undersigned, at his office in the Court House at Bayboro, N. C.
