THE BARBONE FAMILY.
The celebrated name of Prudence God Barbone was borne by a member of the Cromwell parliament called together after the dissolution of the Long parliament in 1653. The royalists called the assembly "Barbone's parliament." At the time when General Monk was in London Barbone headed the mob that presented a petition to parliament against the recall of Charles II. Of the Barbone family there were three brothers, each of whom had a sentence for a name—Prudence God Barbone, Christ-came-into-the-world-to-save-Barbone and If-Christ-had-not-died-thou-hadst-been
