Maritime Notes

Neuse River—approaches to New Bern—buoys established.—On January 4, 1907, the following buoys were established to mark the channel off Fort Point, Neuse River:

Fort channel buoy, 8 1/2 a red spar, numbered 8 1/2 was moored in 11 feet of water to mark the eastern side of the channel, on the bearing:

Duck Creek, upper entrance point, right tangent N 3/4 E.

Johnson Point light SSE 1/4 E.

Lower Green Spring light W. by N. distant, about 1/2 mile.

Fort Point channel buoy, 5 a black spar, numbered 5, was moored in 11 ft. of water to mark the western side of the channel, on the bearing:

Duck Creek, upper entrance, right tangent, N 3/4 E.

Johnson Point light, SSE 1/4 E.

Lower Green Spring light, NW. by W., distant about 1/2 mile.
